

March 2024: Executive Summary – Investigative Detentions

The 4th Amendment analyst reviewed calls for service, cross referenced reports as needed, and reviewed approximately 86 hours and 33 minutes of BWC & In-Car Camera footage uploaded during the month of March that was deemed necessary for examination. In summary of these resources, the Charlottesville Police Department's officers were engaged in 3608 incidents during the month of March. These incidents included officer initiated, citizen assists, and calls for service. Seventeen (17) of these incidents resulted in temporary detentions. Of these 17 incidents, 13 were non-officer initiated and 4 were officer initiated. The chart below provides a summative explanation of these incidents.
