Charlottesville Parks & Recreation maintains a variety of trails in the City. Most are in parks or on school grounds and tend to follow waterways including the Rivanna River and Moore's & Meadow creeks. We strive to keep the trails open for all users and are working on plans to expand and improve the system so it can be enjoyed more frequently by more people.

Trail Rules and Etiquette

- Trails are open dawn-to-dusk
- Dogs must be on a leash, except as posted on the section of the Rivanna Trail within Riverview Park
- Please respect private property along trails between parks and stay on the trail at all times
- No motorized vehicles
- No camping or hunting allowed
- Bicycles yield to pedestrians
- Trashcans are located at trailheads
- Ride, walk, run on the right and pass on the left
- Warn others when passing
