


The mission of the Department of Public Works is to responsibly manage public infrastructure and natural resources

Department Objectives


- The Administration fosters safe, reliable, responsive, and cost-effective provision of services to both the citizens of Charlottesville and internal customers

Regulatory Compliance

- Offers City wide support of compliance efforts such as emissions and MS4

Sustainability & Technical Support

- Provides environmental remediation supervision
- Generates green initiative reports and analysis for transparency and program guidance

Climate Protection Program

- Operates pollution prevention efforts for municipal operations
- Implements emission reduction strategies

Water Conservation

- Implements watershed stewardship projects
- Promotes water conservation efforts for internal and community entities

Water Resources Protection

- Monitors water quality and develops necessary plans of action
- Manages MS4 program elements – erosion/sediment control, stormwater management etc.

Stormwater Utility

- Administers utility and associated budgeting requirements
- Manages related infrastructure planning and replacement


Energy Management

FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT


Facilities Development is responsible for the efficient and cost effective planning, design and construction of projects related to the City-owned public buildings and City School campuses.

Core Programs	Services
Project Planning & Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conducts capital (and other) project planning & complete design services, including cost estimation & project schedules
Project Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manages all design phase services (including A/E consultant teams), LEED submissions, bidding & procurement efforts, fund management, value engineering, constructability reviews, contract negotiations, and scheduling
Construction Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manages all construction phase services, including site inspections, change order management, coordination of third-party testing & inspections, and all owner responsibilities
CIP Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develops & submits facility-related CIP requests (non HVAC) for projects across all City departments, including jointly owned City/County facilities
Facility Needs Assessments, Programming, Space Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Including life cycle cost analysis.
Small Capital Projects	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manage both Government and School's SC programs



FACILITIES MAINTENANCE

Facilities Maintenance provides routine repair and preventive maintenance services City-owned public buildings and City School campuses





PUBLIC SERVICE

Public Service maintains public right-of-ways and the services therein.

Solid Waste and Recycling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manages and oversees the collection of municipal solid waste and recycling
Street & Sidewalks Maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Operates service programs to maintain multi modal transportation assets for safe and efficient use for all
Streetlighting Operations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Catalogues and provides maintenance services for City owned lighting units
Pavement Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manages the City roadway network through detailed condition assessment surveys• Conducts preventative maintenance efforts to increase roadway lifespans and improve quality of traffic conveyance
Traffic Coordination & Maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Manages coordination and maintenance of the City traffic infrastructure network which includes signals, cameras, and signs
Snow Removal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Proactively treats roadways and clears roadways of snow and ice to maintain safety and travel capabilities
Stormwater Maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Operates service programs to maintain stormwater asset functionality and capacity needs
