**A RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the City of Charlottesville Human Rights Commission received an appeal from a finding of no probable cause made by the Officer of Human Rights in the above referenced matter; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City Code Section 2-439.1(a) the Commission is required to review this determination; and

**WHEREAS**, the above referenced matter was before the Commission at their regular meeting in May of 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Complainant and the Respondent were provided with notice of the meeting, afforded an opportunity to be present, and were invited to present any additional information in support of their respective positions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission considered fully the investigative summary, the relevant statements and/or information provided by the parties at the May 2015 meeting and discussed the relevant facts and issues related to the above reference charge and; therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Charlottesville Human Rights Commission, by and through its Officers, adopts the attached determination as to cause. The Office of Human Rights is hereby directed to mail, by first class postage-pre-paid, the attached determination to the Claimant and Respondent in the above referenced matter and to proceed as the Commission directs.
