COVID Exposure Protocol

Charlottesville Parks & Recreation Program Participants

1. Purpose:

The purpose of this procedure is to outline the protocol enacted by the Parks & Recreation Department when a participant informs the department that they have tested positive for COVID-19 and participated in a program or at a facility.

2. Procedure

The following standard operating procedure shall be in effect regarding potential COVID exposure events occurring within Parks & Recreation programs and facilities.

The Department is informed that a participant has a confirmed case of COVID-19 and that participant has participated in a Parks & Recreation program or facility.

1. The Department will perform contact tracing for all person(s) that were potentially exposed to the participant that was infected with COVID.
2. The potentially exposed person(s), regardless of vaccination status, will not be permitted to participate at any Parks & Recreation program or facility for 10 days. Participation may resume on/after the 11th day without requiring negative COVID tests provided that the participant is symptom free.
 - i. Any participant that is showing symptoms of COVID-19 is not permitted to participate at Parks & Recreation programs and facilities.
